Training

24-Hour Mandated Training for Assisted Living Facilities

Training Objective

As required by 198.005 RSMo and 19 CSR 30-86.047, residents of Assisted Living Facilities are required to undergo a community based assessment performed by an appropriately trained and qualified individual. This individual must complete a DHSS approved 24-hour training program prior to performing resident assessments.

Who Should Attend

To meet the statutory and regulatory requirements related to community based assessments, only appropriately trained and qualified individuals may perform the assessment. To qualify as appropriately trained and qualified, the individual must possess the following credentials:

- Licensed or registered with the State of Missouri in a health care related field, or
- Hold a degree in a health care, social services, or human services field, or
- Licensed under Chapter 344, RSMo (Licensed Nursing Home Administrator), and
- Received facility orientation training under 19 CSR 30-86.042 (18), and dementia training under section 660.050, RSMo.

Accreditation

MALA is an approved provider of continuing education through the Missouri Board of Nursing Home Administrators (BNHA). This training has been approved for 14.0 Patient Care hours and 10.0 Administrative hours (TA-046-111). Certificates will be distributed upon conclusion of the workshop.
